Types of MBTI certifications

- Certified MBTI Practitioner
- Master MBTI Practitioner

Types of CEU credits given

- Association for Psychological Type (MBTI)
- 2. American Psychological Assoc. (APA)
- 3. National Board of Certified Counselors (NBCC)

Criteria to provide APTi CEUs-Before

- Program must be taught by an MBTI Master
 Practitioner or approved facilitator and provide:
 - Schedule and format
 - Faculty credentials
 - Educational objectives
 - Number of credits offered (exclude breaks)
 - MBTI topics and activities
- MBTI instrument & its many uses, applications and focus areas will form the basis for the content of the program

Criteria to provide APTi CEUs-During

Provider requires the participants to:

- Sign a roster before the workshop begins
- Attend the workshop in its entirety
- Fill out evaluation forms for both the course and the instructors



Criteria to provide APTi CEUs-After

Provider will provide participants with:

- A certificate of completion on official letterhead that includes:
 - The name of the organization
 - Course title
 - Date of completion
 - Signature of the facilitator or authorizing agent
 - Number of CEU credits awarded
- Graduation code (provided by the MBTI Master Practitioner Program) to be used participants to log their completion



Criteria to provide APTi CEUs-After (cont.)

Provider will provide APTi business office with:

- A list of all training attendees
- A summary of evaluations

How to Become a APTi CEU Provider (cont.)

- 2. Apply online at http://www.mbtimasterpractitioner.org/
 - a) Click on "How to Become a Program Provider"
 - b) Create an account on the website
 - c) Submit a program proposal to the MBTI Master Practitioner Review Board (CPP, AMA, CAPT) for approval:
 - d) -\$30/program or \$100/year (60 days prior to delivery)
 - e) -\$75/conference (120 days prior to delivery)
 - f) A notice of acceptance is sent to the provider within 10 business days
 - g) Approval allows statement and logo to be used & listed on website for approved training programs
 - h) Retain records for 5 years in case of audit



Criteria to provide APA CEUs

- Continuing education (CE) in psychology is an ongoing process consisting of formal learning activities that:
 - (1) are relevant to psychological practice, education and science
 - (2) enable psychologists to keep pace with emerging issues and technologies
 - (3) allow psychologists to maintain, develop, and increase competencies in order to improve services to the public and enhance contributions to the profession.
- Continuing education builds upon a completed doctoral program in psychology. It is **not**:
 - a substitute for the basic academic education and training needed for entry to the field of psychology
 - the primary vehicle for career changes from one APA-recognized specialty area (e.g. clinical, counseling, school psychology) to another.

Criteria to provide NBCC CEUs

Continuing education activities must focus on increasing knowledge and/or skills in the practice of counseling in one or more of the following NBCC approved content areas:

- Counseling theory
- Human growth and development
- Social and cultural foundations
- The helping relationship
- Group dynamics, processing and counseling

Why bother providing CEUs?

- Expand opportunities to pass your insight and knowledge on to a new generation of practitioners, as well as to other experts
- Become a part of a network of MBTI professionals who are committed to the pursuit of excellence and ethical use of the Indicator
- Have the opportunity to see the types of programs others are offering and help meet market demand or differentiate your program accordingly
- Gain increased marketing power for your programs
